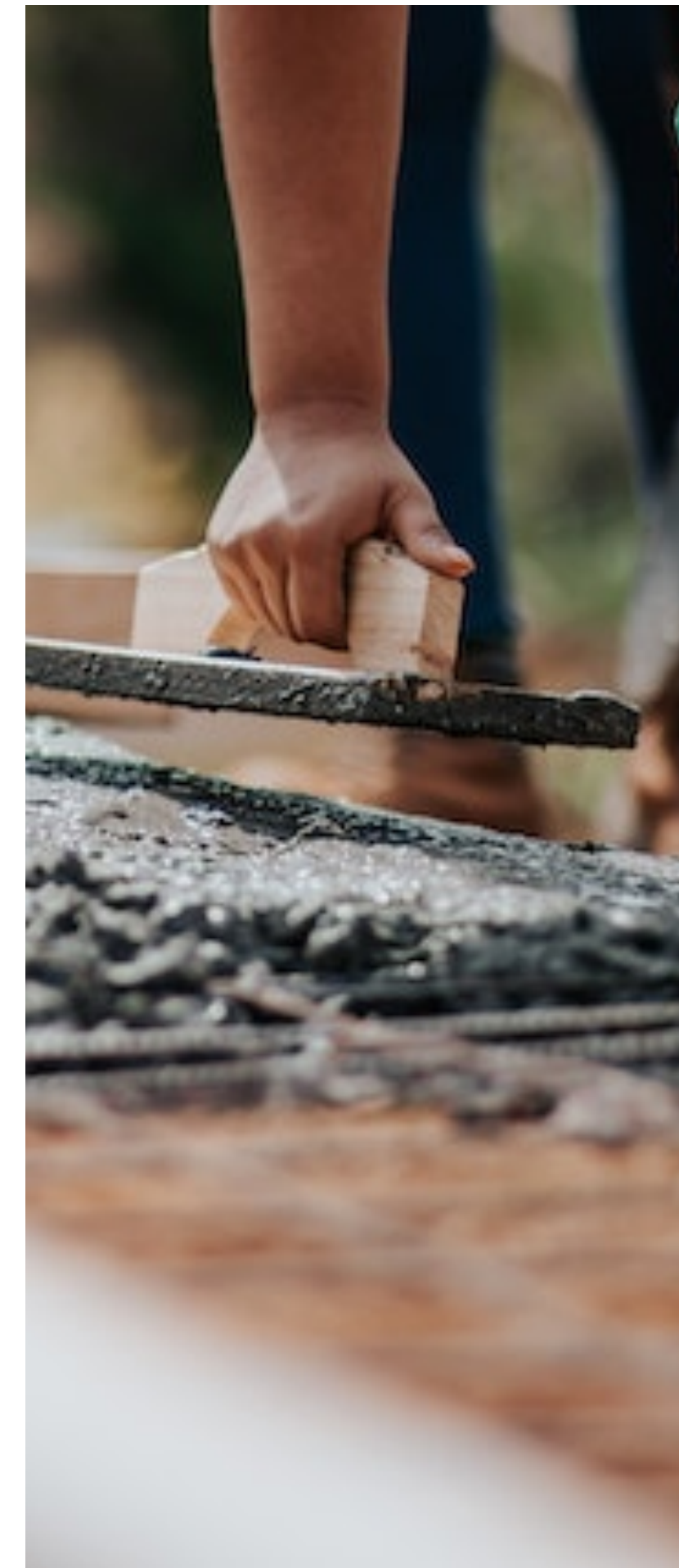

EMERGENCY COVID RELIEF DISTRIBUTION

RATION BOXES AND COVID SUPPLIES DISTRIBUTED TO 255 FAMILIES

PROJECT LOCATION: BANGLADESH

ZamZam Foundation, provided emergency COVID relief to those affected by the pandemic. We distributed COVID supplies, including personal protective equipment (PPE), and sanitizers to quarantine centers, and marginalized communities. Moreover, the organization has also provided employment opportunities to people who have lost their jobs due to the pandemic. By doing so, the foundation is not only helping those affected by COVID-19 but also supporting the livelihoods of those impacted by the economic fallout of the pandemic.

RECYCLED WARMTH - SEASON 01

CREATED 100 JOBS FOR WOMEN IN NEED, & MANUFACTURED AND DISTRIBUTED 3,300 BLANKETS

PROJECT LOCATION: BANGLADESH

We successfully ran our Recycled Warmth Project this year as well. To raise \$28,430 in total, we have successfully benefited 67 underprivileged communities in Bangladesh. The purpose of manufacturing comforters instead of buying ready-made ones was to significantly reduce cost compared to the market price of comforters, provide employment to locals, and promote recycling.

PROVIDED EMERGENCY MEDICAL AID

SPONSORED HEART VALVE REPLACEMENT SURGERY FOR A MOTHER OF THREE

PROJECT LOCATION: BANGLADESH

We collected funds to help a mother of 3 children living in Bangladesh, for her immediate mitral valve replacement. She was first diagnosed with mitral regurgitation in 2017 at the age of 22. Her symptoms worsened and began interfering with her quality of life. Her household jobs, managing children, and daily activities were becoming harder day by day. Her husband is a private school teacher and was barely managing their current living expenses. Access to medical care is essential, and it is acts like these that remind us of the importance of kindness and generosity, and how we can all make a difference in the lives of others.

SUPPORT TO FIRE VICTIM FAMILIES

RECONSTRUCTED NINE HOUSES FOR THE FAMILIES TO START OVER AGAIN.

PROJECT LOCATION: PAKISTAN, BANGLADESH, UGANDA

The devastating fire that occurred on December 6th, 2020 in Chittagong, Bangladesh, resulted in the loss of homes and possessions for nine families. It is heartbreaking to think about the sudden loss these families experienced, but it is also heartening to know that our organization stepped in to help. The provision of food, comforters, clothing, and financial assistance helped these families begin to rebuild their lives. We collected funds to help reconstruct nine houses for the families to start over again.

Education plays a significant part in providing us with ways to make our lives better and easier. Many developing countries are facing the issue of not having effective education systems. This is the case in Kyangwali, Uganda where 3000 Muslim refugees are unable to pursue their education. After recognizing this issue and the educational conditions of these children, we have started the initiative to raise 100,000 USD to address the issue. Our mission is to provide those children with all the necessary education facilities for free such as:

- School Furniture
- Transportation facilities + accessibility
- Employee Salaries
- Lunch Support

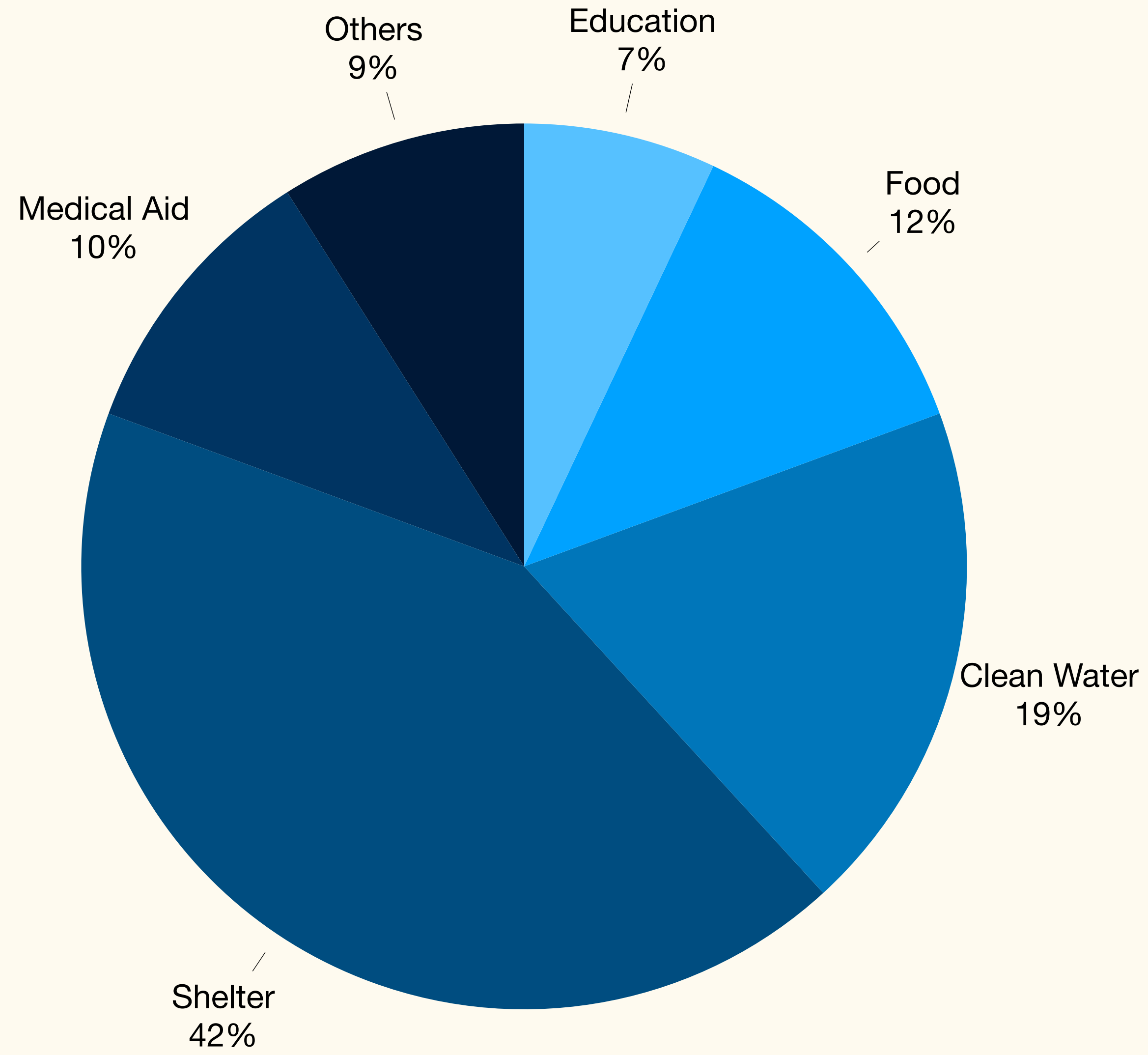
